

Outreach Ideas

Outreach is a great opportunity to serve and heal those in need. Here are a few ideas to help you get started:

1. Hand write and send cards to the elderly, the shut-ins, the imprisoned, and the sick. Reach out to your pastor to request the names and addresses of those in need so you can lend a compassionate hand to this valuable ministry.
2. Contact your pastor to see if he needs help with calling senior citizens, just to talk to them or run errands for them.
3. Spread kindness and inspirational messages via social media. Share uplifting stories or positive affirmations.
4. Read children's books or bible stories, and post on social media for kids to watch.
5. Contact your pastor to volunteer to teach or help out with a Zoom Sunday School class, Diving Deep Discussion, or Bible Study.
6. Make pet toys to donate to animal shelters. Use simple household items like old clothes, pipe cleaners and lots of creativity to make cat and dog toys. You can also donate old or unwanted blankets, sheets, and towels to animal shelters.
7. Make a box of unwanted items to donate to a local charity or shelter, such as clothes, household items, books, and more.
8. Create a "Meals on Wheels" program for the elderly or shut-ins of your parish community, organize a "Midnight Run" to prepare and handout care packages to the homeless, or volunteer to serve at a local food bank.
